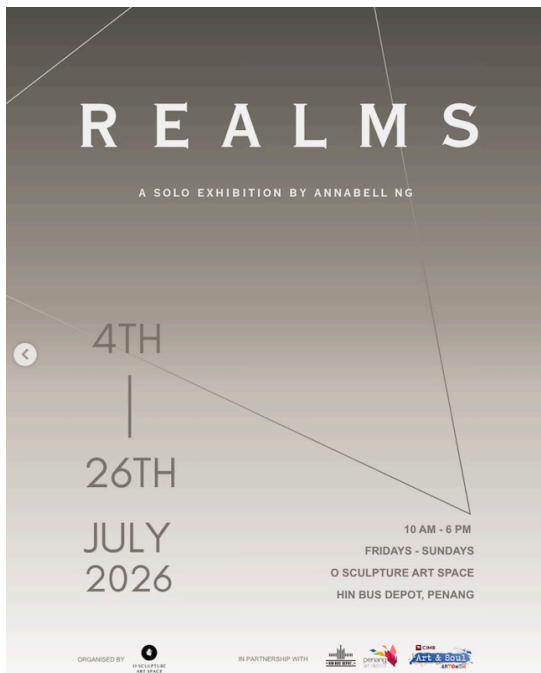

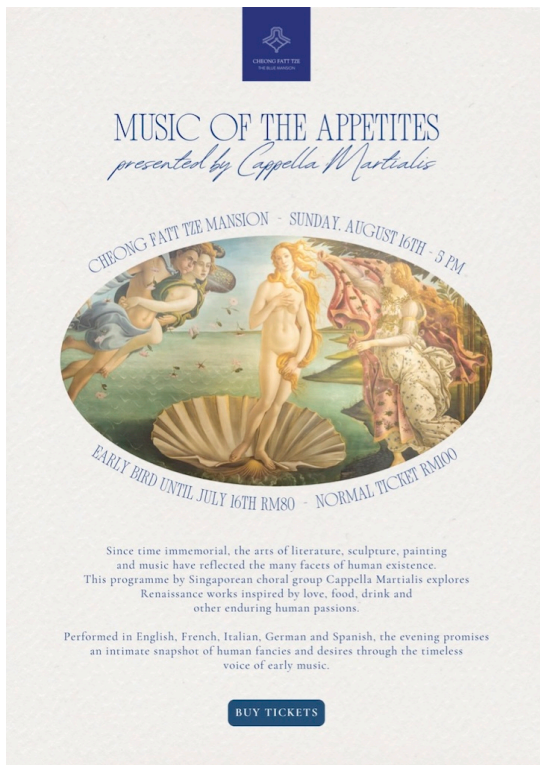

HOW TREE DECISIONS ARE MADE IN DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS

AMIDST THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE PENANG LRT MUTIARA LINE, THE WELL-BEING OF TREES ALONG THE PROJECT IS A CENTRAL PILLAR OF THE PROJECT'S ENVIRONMENTAL COMMITMENT. A MISSION IS CURRENTLY UNDERWAY TO MANAGE THE THOUSANDS OF TREES THAT LINE THE PROJECT'S 23.7KM CORRIDOR.

ARBORIST KARWINA ABU BAKAR IS PART OF THE TEAM LEADING THIS EFFORT OF TREE MANAGEMENT. ARBORISTS ARE CAREFULLY ASSESSING EACH TREE BASED ON THEIR HEALTH, STRUCTURAL CONDITION AND WHETHER IT CAN BE SAFELY RELOCATED.
